## Fast Facts: Lisa Neubauer

- For Lisa Neubauer, Democratic politics is the family business.
  - According to the [Milwaukee Journal Sentinel](#)
    - “Neubauer and her husband have given \$105,000 to liberal and Democratic candidates and causes.”
    - Neubauer worked for Senator Fred Risser (D-Madison) and worked as an assistant Midwest coordinator for Gary Hart’s 1984 campaign for president.
  - Lisa Neubauer was appointed to the Wisconsin Court of Appeals, District II by Governor Jim Doyle.
- Neubauer received the endorsement of the Wisconsin Working Families Party (WWFP). Senator Bernie Sanders said the Working Families Party is “the closest thing” to a party that believes in socialism.
  - “If Neubauer wins her election, the balance of power on the Court will shift toward more progressive jurists,” [wrote the WWFP in its press release endorsing Neubauer](#).
- Labor Unions are backing Neubauer heavily. Union contributions totaled \$117,000 making up nearly 20% of her total donations as of the last finance reporting period (February 4).
- Liberal special interest groups are backing Neubauer. A group run by former Obama Administration Attorney General Eric Holder, the National Democratic Redistricting Committee, [is committing \\$350,000 to help get Lisa Neubauer elected](#), according to *Wisconsin Public Radio*.
- [Lisa Neubauer withheld the names of clients which paid her family millions](#) on her annual Statements of Economic Interest for years. These are important public documents which can shed light on potential conflicts of interest for public employees.
  - This raises serious ethical questions. What else is she hiding? The voters deserve to know.
